-Committees:

-Finance-

- \$40000.00 surplus showing, compared to last year of \$80000.00. This number does include the PPP load showing as Expenses as it has not been forgiven yet.

- School and Capital improvements still doing well.

- Cafeteria's sheets had questions regarding how much we were being reimbursed per child from grant, as Mary says we receive more than we charge per kid and Cindy is showing we receive less. Matt was going to ask Cindy to clarify.

- Paul asked if the Capital Improvement fund could be used to help repair the leaks in the roof, Matt/father checking to see if there are specific qualifications a project has to be before we can use those funds.

-School-

- In school over 100 consecutive days.

- grant money was used to update the PA system in the school, and will be used to purchase more chrome books, new cart and Laminator for the school.

- Kindergarten open house will be 3/14 after 10:30 mass, Mary expects about 15 new kids.

- Mrs. Clark will be retiring this year so preparations are in place for her send off, and Mary requested a mass for her.

Christian Service-

- Lighting on statues is completed.
