- -Confirmation & First Communion classes still going on
- -Elementary Faith Formation will be meeting 45 mintues prior to Ash Wednesday mass as a family
- -Youth Group has 9-12 kids coming on a regular basis
- -April 26th will be the next parish Euchre tournament. Mary Beth Hauck is running it, Sandy is helping. Any age is welcome & you don't need to have a partner to sign up.

School Commission – MARY HAUCK

- -Climate survey results are posted on the school website
- -March 15th after 10:30 mass will be Kindergarten round up advertising on CFX & Facebook
- -Teacher appreciate week will be May 4 8
- -New Alumni Spotlight is up
- -Open house at homecoming they are going to dig up the old time capsule and put a new one in
- -Working on Endowment, we need to set a goal and then find out how much is needed
- -Discussed the teacher salary, St Joes teacher are paid about \$26,000 a year, while BCHS teachers make \$37,500. How do we compare to other schools?

Stewardship Commission – KATHLEEN SCHAFER

- -Bookmarks in pews were a hit. They are working on more for Lent, but it is a process. They had done 380 for Advent season
- -Time & Talent Survey Mary has them & will re-send to Duane Schafer. She stated they are going out with the kids at school. We are in need of ushers, perhaps we should send out sooner rather than later.
- -Flower Garden Maintenance for upcoming spring we need a lead person, Erika will be putting in bulletin to see if any interest. By having the commission each take a turn saved \$8,000 \$10,000. A one time spring clean-up will be needed, after that once a week is good to keep it up.

VII Standing Issues – ROOF Issues

Paul wanted to know who was on the building & grounds committee. Elton thought there were 3 members (Mike Pasch, Bob Curtiss & Leon Cotter), but they don't meet regularly. Paul is going to reach out to them. Chris stated that heat tape is needed and that it should be re-sealed every couple of years. If snow is gone, Chris will try to get photos for the next meeting.

VIII Old Business -

- -Parishioner letters went out. Cindy is keeping track of them. They are due back by March 15.
- -Erika ministry structure was discussed
 - *currently making \$12.48/hr. for both jobs
 - *Erin talked to the diocese, we can pay her 2 different payrolls for her 2 different jobs
 - *We won't have to worry about a sub as they aren't regular and don't have to be on the Payroll

Proposed raising the stipend to \$65 per mass, Paul made a motion to approve, 2nd by Terrie.

IX New Business -

- Erin asked us all to review the Strategic plan; how does pastoral and finance work together? Pastoral needs to be involved in the "vision", we need to be working together. Where do we look for opportunities? What is our timeline to implement?
- Discussed moving Pastoral meeting to a different night. We would ask the commission to give
 us a written report that we can then review at our meeting, instead of them reporting at our
 meeting. This would allow the Pastoral group more time for other discussion. We could have 1
 committee report based on what is important at that time. We thought it would be good to
 implement this starting in September with the new year.
- Erin asked ALL commissions to provide Pastoral their full budget request by May. Any money to be spent be given by March meeting and get a list of any "wish list" items or changes they have.
